CHIC (Covenant High in Christ) is a triennial Christian conference for high school students sponsored by the Evangelical Covenant Church, held at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, July 14-21. More than 6000 youth from all over North America and around the world will gather for a week of life changing teaching from speakers like Francis Chan and Lou Giglio, diverse worship experiences including service, and a challenge to become world changers. The purpose of CHIC is to be a catalyst that inspires Christ-like change; challenging students to see themselves as part of something bigger and inspiring students on the journey of following Christ.
